We currently have an opportunity for a Billposter / General Labourer to join our Operations team in Vancouver.

Our Street Operations Team is looking to expand and bring onboard a team-oriented individual to help support and perform specific tasks for Vancouver's Street Furniture installed along the City's sidewalk. Street Furniture equipment includes; bus shelters, bus benches, standalone map stands, litter receptacles, washrooms, bike racks, and kiosks.

In this role, YOU will be responsible for

1. Reporting to the yard at the beginning and end of your shift
2. Driving to multiple sites within the City per day
3. Providing small onsite repairs on transit shelters. Small repairs include, adjusting/changing locks, doors, light bulbs as well as performing glass panel replacements, seating repairs and some painting
4. Providing on site window washing and other cleaning tasks. Manual window/amenity cleaning and pressure washing
5. Prepping and posting advertising posters as scheduled at multiple sites
6. Cleaning and minor repairs to automated washrooms
7. Operating manual & power tools and gas-powered equipment including pressure washers, edge trimmers, generators, drills and grinders.
8. Ensuring all health and safety policies and procedures are followed
9. Providing operational support to the team as directed
10. Serve as a daily liaison with other team members and management
11. Interact with the general public, neighbours and transit riders at bus stop(s)

- Moderate to heavy lifting up to 75 lbs;
